POLICIES

- **Consent Workshops:** smaller groups, attention to the spectrum of sexual harassment through to assault and discussion of consent within relationships and emotional manipulation.
- **Promote a zero-tolerance policy** on sexual assault and harassment within college and work with college and Jan to make it easier for victims to come forward and work through their experiences.
- **Legislation:** work with college to review sexual harassment and assault policies are in place, up to date and are distributed to all students. Review and add to legislation protecting the interests of women and non binary-students at Pembroke.
- **Space Spaces:** hold monthly safe-space workshops for women and non-binary students and work with Men's/ Ents officers to ensure that Bop remains a safe space.
- **Diversity:** work with BME and Access officers to increase the racial diversity of women within college and collaborations with FLY.
- **Charity:** select a charity that supports women and run fundraising events for it throughout the year.
- **Organize a feminist reading group** that meets twice a term to give people access to feminism and feminist literature, the reading list would be made widely available and racially divers.
- **Speakers :** collaborate with Pembroke Politics, Fly other college feminist societies to bring more female speakers, both political and from across the professional world to Pembroke.
- **Increase Engagement with Feminism :** create a term card of events which would include spoken-word, women's art and music nights, a greater diversity of topics in discussion groups.
- **Available to Talk :** work with the Welfare Team to run drop in sessions.
